- e) Scholarship will be awarded by the American Legion Auxiliary upon high school graduation and is to be used for strictly for post-secondary expenses
- f) Applicants are to write a one page essay describing themselves, their goals, and explain how the scholarship will help them meet those goals
- g) Applicants should submit essay to the school counselor by April 30th to be considered
